As a Joey Soccer coach, parent, organiser and volunteer it is important to support the children's footballing activities in a positive manner both on and off the pitch. It is essential that parents and spectators act appropriately, demonstrate high standards of behaviours and act as role models for children.

It is important that as a coach, parent, organiser and volunteer, I will:

- ❸ Remember that players participate for fun and winning is only part of the fun
- Remember that children participate in sport for their own enjoyment, not yours
- Be fair, considerate and honest with all players
- Encourage children to participate but not force or pressure them
- Socus on children's effort and performance not the score
- Encourage children to play fairly and within the rules
- Over ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or not winning
- Never criticise or ridicule any child's performance after a game
- Treat all players, coaches, referees, officials, administrators, parents and spectators with respect and courtesy. Encourage children to do the same
- Never argue with the referee, respect their decisions and teach children to do the same
- Refrain from any form of abuse directed at players, coaches, referees, officials, parents or spectators
- ✤ Refrain from crude, foul, derogatory, offensive or abusive language
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of everyone involved regardless of gender, ability, cultural background or religion
